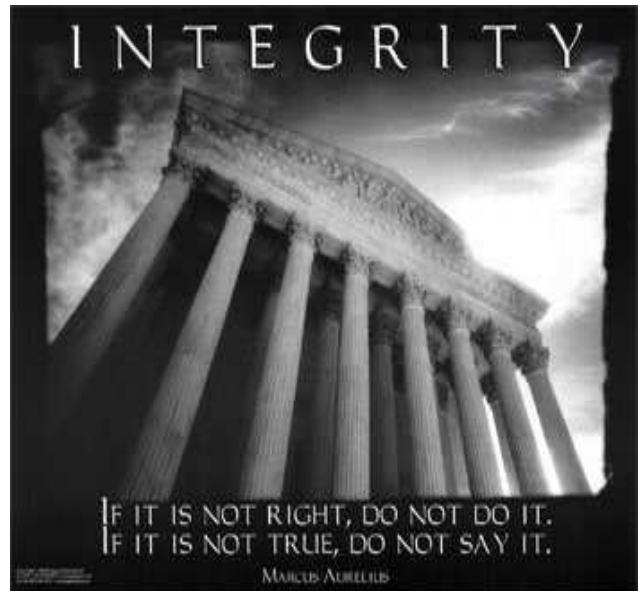


THE MPC CHARACTER TRAIT FOR MAY – JUNE, 2011 IS ‘INTEGRITY’.

Identifying unsuitable candidates can save the employer from problems that might otherwise arise during a term of employment.
