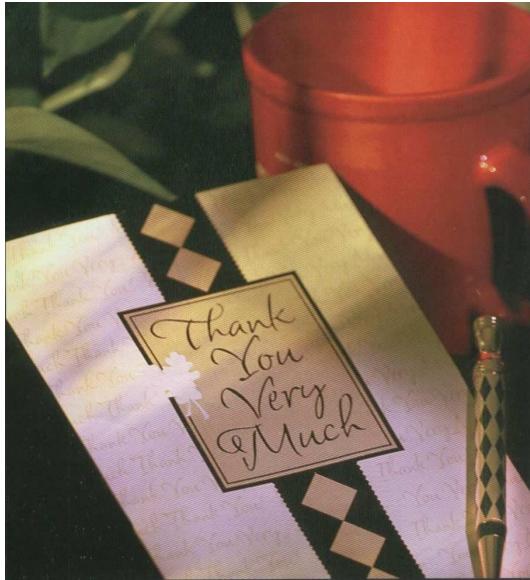


### THE MPC CHARACTER TRAIT FOR MARCH – APRIL 2012 IS ‘COURTESY’
