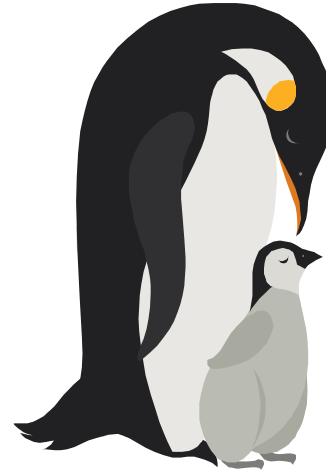


THE MPC CHARACTER TRAIT FOR MAY – JUNE 2013 IS ‘DILIGENCE’
